Setup OpenVPN Client on Android

Install OpenVPN Client App

- Open the Google Play Store
- Search for "OpenVPN Connect"
- Tap Install and wait for the download

Method: Download

Step 1: Obtain VPN Configuration Files

- Download the .ovpn file from https://app.vpneverywhere.com/vpn-certificates
- Save it to Downloads, Cloud (Google Drive, Dropbox) or email it to yourself

Step 2: Import the Configuration into the App

- Open the OpenVPN Connect app
- Tap "OVPN Profile" or "Import Profile > File > Upload File"
- Navigate to the location where your .ovpn file is stored
- Tap the .ovpn file to import
- Enter a Profile Name
- Tap "Add" or "Save"

Step 3: Connect to the VPN

- Tap the Toggle switch (or Connect)
- Grant VPN connection permission if asked
- Wait for "Connected" status
- If successful, the connection status should turn green and show connection stats

Step 4: Verify VPN Connection

- Check your IP address using a service like https://whatismyipaddress.com
- You should see your VPN server's IP, not your original one

Setup OpenVPN Client on Windows

Install OpenVPN Client

- Go to OpenVPN's official website https://openvpn.net/community-downloads
- Download the OpenVPN Connect client for Windows
- Run the installer and follow the setup wizard (keep default settings)
- Allow the TAP driver installation when prompted

Method: Download

Step 1: Obtain VPN Configuration Files

- Download the .ovpn file from https://app.vpneverywhere.com/vpn-certificates
- Save files in an easily accessible folder

Step 2: Import the Configuration into the App

- Right-click the OpenVPN GUI shortcut on your desktop or Start menu
- Select "Run as administrator"
- OpenVPN icon appear in the system tray (lower right corner of your screen)
- Right-click the OpenVPN tray icon, click on "Import Profile"
- Browse to your .ovpn file and select it and click Import

Step 3: Connect to the VPN

- Select your imported profile from the list
- Click Connect, Grant permission if Windows asks for VPN access
- Wait for "Connected" status.
- If successful, the connection status should turn green and show connection stats.

Step 4: Verify VPN Connection

- Check your IP address using a service like https://whatismyipaddress.com
- You should see your VPN server's IP, not your original one
